(\*Includes food & accommodations per person. Please add \$145 pp to visit Ngorongoro National Park).



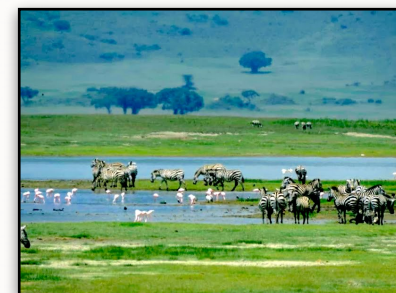
## EDUCATION ~

- ❖ Engage children ages three to thirteen via educational activities at Ikirwa School, a private, NGO-funded English Medium primary school.
- ❖ Interact with children via structured activities that encourage cross-cultural discussions and the sharing of ideas and viewpoints.



## ENRICHMENT ~

- ❖ Create a published project that promotes diversity, communication, and collaboration (additional details revealed upon registration).
- ❖ Participate in outdoor activities with children on the school's playing fields.



## EXPLORATION ~

- ❖ Observe the majestic wildlife in Arusha's Tarangire and Lake Manyara National Parks. *Optional visit to Ngorongoro National Park for an additional fee.*

## Our Mission

Ikirwa School was born out of a campfire conversation between a Tanzanian guide and a tourist. The school opened its doors in January of 2013 and obtained the Tanzanian government registration by December of that year. Their vision is to develop a single-stream English Medium school by growing the academic program organically and pragmatically, adding one grade per year, while generating sufficient revenue to cover day-to-day operations and building a positive reputation in the community. They leverage volunteer and NGO resources to provide students world-class academic instruction and education materials, as well as career development opportunities for teachers. The current enrollment stands at 200 students in Baby Class through Form 7.
